BOARD COMMITTEE REPORTS:

offer curb-side pick up and they have a virtual reading program. Boys & Girls Club raffle will be coming up and they would like to re-open in early July. STAC report that the sidewalk is installed in front of the senior center.

Councilman Ivino – conversation with Adele about moving animals up here from people who have passed from COVID-19 to be adopted out of the shelter. Supervisor Costello added that a lot of the animals coming up are puppies. Thanks to all for safe and smooth march last week.

Councilman Schoonmaker – it is kitten season and the shelter has adopted 40+ in the past two weeks. The portrait contest winner will sell prints and give the profit to the shelter. Motion made by Councilman Schoonmaker, seconded by Supervisor Costello to authorize the sale of aforementioned equipment through Auctions International or other source, as per the recommendation of the Parks & Buildings Superintendent. Vote: Adopted – 4 Yes (Councilman Andreassen absent)

Motion made by Councilman Ivino, seconded by Councilman Schoonmaker to authorize the purchase, to replace aforementioned Backhoe/Loader, one (1) downsized Mini-excavator 8800, Model #R35Z-9A, with tooth and flat buckets, off Sourcewell Municipal Cooperative Purchasing Contract #0321119-HCE, through A. Montano and Company, at a cost of \$45,050.00 (less than state contract). Cost to be paid from funds previously received from Auctions International from sales of previously sold equipment and materials, along with funds from current sale of above listed equipment and as per 2020 budget line items #A1620.200, #A7110.200, #B7110.200, as per the recommendation of the Parks & Buildings Superintendent. Motion made by Supervisor Costello, seconded by Councilman Ivino to adopt Local Law No. 3 of 2020 amending Vehicles and Traffic Law. Vote: Adopted – 4 Yes (Councilman Andreassen absent)

Motion made by Supervisor Costello, seconded by Councilman Schoonmaker to adjourn Town Board Meeting at 7:50 p.m., carried.
