Councilman Schirmer – Ethics Committee will resume meetings on October 11<sup>th</sup>.

Councilwoman Thornton – CPC met but there was no quorum. TV23 has new programs; CAC will hold a public meeting on October 19<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. for a Bristol Beach up-date. STAC has an opening on the committee and Lifespring has started their fall session. Al Bruno spoke for the STAC committee on parking in the village. He has spoken with Carl Walker Designs and they came up with some ideas for parking behind Mirabella's. It was \$18,200.00 for the parking study to be done.

Councilman Costello – police department has had a busy month with Garlic Festival, event at Jewish Congregation and event on Patch Road – all went well. Greg Chorvas said preliminary numbers for attendance at Garlic Festival for Saturday are 18,000 and on Sunday 22,000. There were no problems, parking went extremely well. RV and preferred parking brought in \$23,400.00. Electric charging station is up and running and the free electric is coming from VW.

Councilman Bruno – past Monday, had a meeting with businesses and school. The workforce is different than thought, will have a follow-up meeting. SHS has hired a tech teacher.

Discussion: Councilman Schirmer said that while the water tank project was going on, heavy equipment had damaged the road.

Motion made by Councilman Costello, seconded by Councilman Bruno authorizing Superintendent of Highways, Douglas F. Myer to hire Michael Kohler as a part time "as needed" laborer for winter snow removal at a rate of \$15.00 per hour. Vote: Adopted – 5 Yes

Motion made by Councilman Bruno, seconded by Councilman Schirmer to appoint Paul Andreassen as the regular representative for the Town of Saugerties on the Ulster County Planning Board from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2021. Vote: Adopted – 5 Yes

Motion made by Councilman Bruno, seconded by Councilman Costello to appoint Robert Hlavaty as an alternate representative for the Town of Saugerties on the Ulster County Planning Board from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2021. Vote: Adopted – 5 Yes

Motion made by Supervisor Helsmoortel, seconded by Councilman Bruno to approve an increase in salary for Elly Monfett, animal shelter employee, to \$15.50 per hour with an effective date of January 1, 2017.

Discussion: Supervisor Helsmoortel said that she has not received an increase since she was hired.

Vote: Adopted – 5 Yes

Motion made by Councilwoman Thornton, seconded by Councilman Costello to approve a 2% increase in salary for the following employees: Claudette Zinkow, Kate Cappello, Leslie Duffy and Terri Wood with an effective date of January 1, 2017.
