Meritorious Leader Award was given to Sgt. Kevin Drescher. Frank Ferraro was awarded the Civilian Life Saving Award for rescuing an individual from a house fire on December 13, 2004. Moment of Silence observed in memory of town employee Robert Mignano, who passed away unexpectedly last Friday. Our deepest sympathy to his daughter Becky, who also works in our Parks and Recreation Department.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD:

Herve Senequier – handed the Town Board and Clerk, for the record, 2004 listings and closings for property in the Town of Saugerties. Has petition being circulated regarding how the assessments were done and wants another independent assessment done. Also, not in favor of casino, hopefully there will be a referendum.

Eric Tietjen – the town needs more affordable housing.

Marjory Greenberg-Vaughn – at the last board meeting, asked for a board member to be liaison with public – has this been discussed or any action taken. Not in favor of casino, every other community that has casino has suffered.

Gail Pfleghaar – would like the signs for the bike route put up.

Donald Tucker – wants action taken on internal matter with Police Department that was discussed in Executive Session. Something needs to be resolved. Supervisor is not getting information.

Lanny Walter – board has been too polite to Indian tribe. Community does not want the casino. Has written resolution to prohibit casino gambling, gave example to town board for use, if they choose. "No Saugerties Casino" group is being formed with a meeting on May 31, 2005 at 7:00 p.m. at the Senior Citizen Building. A petition is also being circulated opposing the casino.

Steven Haun – tribe has met with the Town Board but not with the public. This will be soverign land, will they police themselves, take care of fire, garbage disposal and water sources. Also, still dissatisfied with assessment problems.

Judy Lechner – opposed to casino, please come to meeting on May 31, we will take action. Town Board should hire outside counsel to deal with Indian tribe; there will likely be litigation.

Sam Lazarus – moved here six years ago because of the beautiful village and town. Casino will spoil the landscape. Search your souls before you sell the town.

Reminder that all town offices will be closed on Monday, May 30, 2005 in observance of Memorial Day.
