Old Business

Leslie reported that she was unable to find any suction solutions to remove the Milfoil from the creek that don't require divers. She reported that a new effective herbicide, Procella, has been approved by NY State as a method for the removal of Milfoil. The need for town and village officials to agree on a treatment method for the problem of Milfoil infestation in the creek was expressed.

Vernon reported that establishing a CCA is complicated and the town is exploring the possibility of establishing a CCA within Saugerties.

Mary O'Donnell shared information on Wheelabrator, a company that is proposing to deposit incinerated ask at site near the Hudson River in Catskill. A public meeting to discuss the Wheelabrator's proposal is set for April 23 at the Catskill Community Center.
